

Mark Gaston Pearce (mark.pearce@georgetown.edu) is a visiting professor and executive director of the Georgetown University Law Center, Workers' Rights Institute. He is also an AAA and FMCS panel arbitrator and is a fellow of the NAA. Formerly a two term Board Member and Chairman of the National Labor Relations Board. Mr. Pearce sits on the board of governors of the College of Labor and Employment Lawyers and he currently serves by presidential appointment on the Federal Service Impasse Panel. He has presented and written extensively on issues related to the employment status of college athletes and was chairman of the NLRB when it declined jurisdiction over the labor representation petition filed by the Northwestern University football players.
