THEODORE J. ST. ANTOINE

Theodore J. (Ted) St. Antoine is the Degan Professor Emeritus of Law at the University of Michigan. After practicing labor law with Woll, Mayer & St. Antoine in Washington, D.C., he joined the Michigan Law School faculty in 1965. He was Dean from 1971 to 1978. He has written widely on labor law and has edited several books in the field, including the National Academy of Arbitrators' *The Common Law of the Workplace: The Views of Arbitrators*.

St. Antoine was a labor arbitrator for over 50 years and was President of the NAA in 1999-2000. He is a past Secretary and Council member of the ABA's Labor and Employment Law Section and a past Chairperson of the Michigan Bar's Labor and Employment Law Section. He also chaired the Michigan Attorney Discipline Board and the UAW's Public Review Board. He has been a Visiting Professor at Cambridge, Duke, George Washington, Illinois, and Tokyo Universities.
