

## BARRY WINOGRAD

Barry Winograd has been an arbitrator and mediator of labor and employment cases, as well as other civil disputes, since 1988. Mr. Winograd has served on the adjunct law school faculty at the University of California, Berkeley for over 35 years teaching labor law and arbitration courses and has also taught at the University of Michigan and the University of Pennsylvania. In addition, he has written articles for professional journals on labor relations, arbitration, and mediation, has been an editor of a treatise on employment law and dispute-resolution, and has contributed to amicus briefs in Supreme Court proceedings. Before becoming an arbitrator and mediator, Mr. Winograd was an administrative law judge for the California Public Employment Relations Board and an attorney for the United Farm Workers of America. Mr. Winograd received his B.A. at the University of California, Santa Barbara, and his J.D. and LL.M from Berkely Law.
