Arnold Zack has been arbitrating since 1968, served as President of the National Academy of Arbitrators in 1994-1995. During that time he was responsible for the development of the Due Process Protocol and the designation of Ted St. Antoine to be editor of the Common Law of the Workplace. He has been appointed by four Presidents to serve on six Presidential Emergency Boards and served as Judge and later President of the Administrative Tribunal of the Asian Development Bank. He has written several books on mediation, arbitration and labor training in developing countries. He also edited Arbitration in Practice (Cornell ILR 1984) containing papers delivered at conference arranged by St Antoine in Ann Arbor.
