

Joyce Sadka – Short Bio

Dr. Joyce Sadka is a professor and chair of the Department of Law at the Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México, ITAM, in Mexico City. She holds a JD and a PhD in Economics.

For the past two decades, Joyce has conducted empirical research on labor law and labor justice, including the design and implementation of field experiments in labor courts, that contributed scientific evidence in the design of Mexico's new labor law. Since 2020, Joyce has been involved with several technical assistance projects that seek to improve the implementation of the new labor justice regime, through the creation of case management systems and training programs for Labor Conciliation Centers and Labor Courts. She is the co-director of the ENLACE project, dedicated to Enhancing Labor Conciliation in Mexico.
