Suonty is an Arbitrator at the Arbitration Council of Cambodia (AC) for more than 15 years. During the time at AC, she has been conducting mediation, arbitral hearings and co-authored hundreds of arbitral awards concerning collective labor disputes. She also participated in drafting policies and procedures for AC hearings and was a member of the AC Working Group responsible for reviewing ambiguous provisions in the Cambodian Labor Law and preparing proposals for submission to the Ministry of Labor and Vocational Training for amendment.

Suonty also worked as an independent and legal consultant on several large international and national projects for multinational and private entities UNDP, MPDF, the Council for Development of Cambodia, IUCN, VDB Loi, DFDL and PricewaterhouseCoopers. She also provided lectures to undergraduate students in various prestigious universities in Cambodia.

Suonty is an Attorney registered with the Bar Association of the Kingdom of Cambodia. She holds a Master of Public Administration from Columbia University in the US under the support of the Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program (JJ/WBJSP) and a Master of Law and a Certificate in Taxation Law from Temple University School of Law in the US under the support of the Fulbright grant.
