Sherrie Rose Talmadge has maintained a full-time arbitration practice for close to thirty years. A 1980 graduate of Suffolk Law School, Ms. Talmadge serves as arbitrator, mediator, and factfinder with a broad range of experience with both public and private sector issues. Currently, she sits on the Board of Governors for the National Academy of Arbitrators, in addition to participation in a number of committees, and is active in the New England Chapter of the NAA. As a member of the International Studies Committee, Ms. Talmadge was part of the NAA delegation to Cambodia in 2022 to meet with members of the Arbitration Council of Cambodia. Ms. Talmadge has participated in workshops, seminars and lectures for various organizations including the AAA and the URI Labor Arbitration Conference. Ms. Talmadge is a member of the permanent panels of the American Arbitration Association, the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, The Labor Connection, and various state and city panels. For over 30 years, Ms. Talmadge has served on the United States Postal Service panels with its three major crafts (NALC, APWU and NPMHU). Prior to starting her full-time arbitration practice, Ms. Talmadge held the position of Administrative Law Judge/Hearing Officer for the Massachusetts Labor Relations Commission (currently, Department of Labor Relations) for ten years, and worked for three years as an Arbitrator/Mediator for the Massachusetts Board of Conciliation and Arbitration. Ms. Talmadge is an Advisory Committee member (and former President) of the Massachusetts Chapter of the Labor and Employment Relations Association (LERA).
