There are many ways a person can resolve disputes without going to trial. Common ADR processes include mediation, arbitration, and neutral evaluation. These processes are generally confidential, less formal, and less stressful than traditional court proceedings. A Neutral Evaluation (NE) is a process that allows each side to present written and oral summaries of its case to a "neutral" person, called an "evaluator." This is a dispute resolution technique – at mid-point between mediation and binding adjudication – that can stand on its own or be integrated.
