Betty Ginsburg is the director of ALPA's Representation Department. In that role she oversees the ALPA staff members who lead negotiations and contract administration (including grievance processing and arbitration) for all ALPA-represented pilot groups in the U.S. and Canada.

Before moving to ALPA's Representation Department in 2011 Betty worked for 24 years as an attorney in ALPA's Legal Department, ultimately holding the position of Managing Attorney.

A California native from the agricultural heart of the state, Betty attended and achieved her law degree from Berkeley Law at the University of California, Berkeley. She began practice at the National Treasury Employees Union representing U.S. Treasury Department employees including Customs and IRS agents. She joined the firm of Friedman & Wirtz, representing labor unions including railroad unions covered by the Railway Labor Act, before coming to ALPA in 1987.
